Nadayoga society approved to start a craft working center for rural schedule cast, tribal women and handicapped. From 01-12-2008 the 3 months training was held at Nadayoga ashram in co-operation with Shramik kala NGO of Mekalmardi, Belgaum dist. 25 rural women were trained to make various designs of jute bags and laundry baskets.
